## The Wheat Sheaf of Unity for the Omer-counting Returning Ten Tribes



## Vision received on 22nd of Aviv, 5772 / 4-14-2012, on Shabbat at end of Days of Unleavened Bread, 8th day of the Omer Count Torah Reading Ex. 33:12 – 34:26, Num. 28:19:25, Haftarah Ez. 37:1-14

## Narrative by the receiver:

"This morning I was reading the Torah readings and then started to pray. I felt in my heart just to pour out my feelings that were in my heart today and it all centered on those still held captive by the nations that they were sent to. I prayed for Ephraim, I prayed that we would be gathered, to become strong and united as a people. I had a vision, a short vision.

I saw a sheaf of grain except at closer look, each stalk of grain was a real person, and we were gathered in a bundle. We all had our arms around each other and were pressed together so tightly as we were bound together and tied with straw or twine.

This may be significant as we are counting the Omer, YHWH is gathering us. I am reminded of Joseph's dream in Genesis 37 and also an old song sung in Christianity "Bringing in the Sheaves." I was encouraged and it was a beautiful image."

## **Comment:**

This vision is very well explained by the receiver's description and by the very self-explanatory visual message of the "wheat sheaf of people." If anything we need, it is unity. Unity in identity, purpose and task. When we unite in these three aspects, we will have the esprit d'corps to unify us. When we are unified, we will receive the Power from on High. First we need to unify. Here is how.

In *identity*, we need to be united as the people gathered as written on the stick of Joseph: "Joseph and his companions," (Ez. 37:15). We are to identify as all those who identify as returning Ten Tribers into the Camp of Joseph, and all those who join them; those who are taking hold of the Covenant, as prophesied in Isaiah 56.

In *purpose*, we need to unite as those who realize that our "resurrection from the Valley of Dry Bones" was bestowed on us for a purpose.
